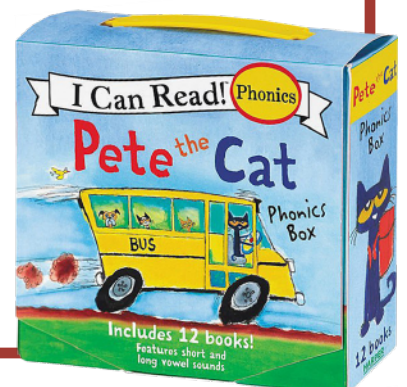


Sight Words
